How to inspect before use

Ensure your safety, the safety of your site and teammates when conducting inspections. All inspections of Chain Blocks shall be conducted in accordance with the relevant standards.

Inspect all the components of the Chain Block thoroughly

1. Mandatory Markings



2. Functional Test



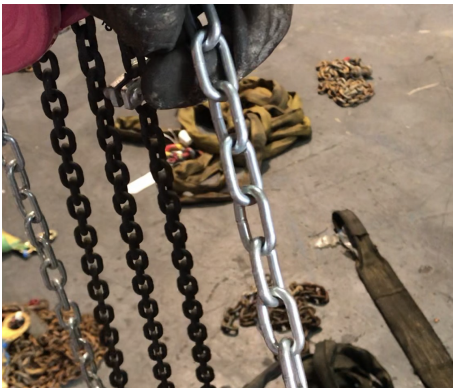
3. Top Hook Assembly



4. Body



5. Hand & Load Chains



6. Bottom Hook Assembly



what to look for

Corrosion, Cracks, Cuts, Deformation, Distortion, Gouges, Heat Damage, Nicks, Worn.

NOTE: Pay particular attention to the hooks for signs of overloading.
